The Township Entrepreneurship Awards will be held on the 18^{th} of August 2018 at Carnival City, in Brakpan, Ekurhuleni.

TV SERIES PROCESS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

The TV series process was aimed at selecting the entrepreneur of the year and different rules

were applied. The focus was more on the entrepreneur (the individual), while the focus on

the category criteria and selection process was on the enterprise or management of the

business.

The criteria used to nominate the top ten finalists to participate in the 6 episodes were

communicated to the entrepreneurs during the briefing session and the details were

provided at the start of each activity daily. The overarching criteria used to select the

entrepreneur of the year included:

1. Capacity to Handle Pressure (3 Min Pitch)

2. Innovation & Creativity

3. Profitability

4. Presentation Skills

5. Group Dynamics (Team Work/ Team Player)

6. Project Management

7. Management/ Leadership Skills (Lead a Team)

8. Passion of the Entrepreneur

9. Business Acumen

The process was divided into six elimination stages, which will be a reflection of the 6

episodes.
